Responsibilities

Qualifications

- Passion for social media, ideally with experience of Newsletters (MailChimp), Twitter, Video Platforms (e.g. YouTube / Vimeo), LinkedIn, Facebook, WordPress
- Experience or interest in online and digital multimedia production
- High level of proficiency in Microsoft Office and Google docs/sheets
- Ability to use design software at a basic level, e.g. Adobe Indesign/Photoshop or similar,
- In possession of a computer/laptop (PC or Mac) equipped with Microsoft Office and internet
- Required: Self-starter, attention to detail and able to work to tight deadlines
- We will also consider anyone with international social media production experience (ie, not the standard 'Western' grouping of platforms)
- An understanding of strategic foresight and its use in policy/strategy is desirable
